TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Mayfield Courier agrees to transport the property described herein subject to the terms and conditions described by the Public Commercial Vehicles Act and Regulations of Quebec and Ontario except as hereinafter provided, and in accordance with the rules and regulations published in the carrier's Tariff of Tolls in effect on the date hereof to which the shipper assents and as evidence thereof accepts this receipt.

DELAY

Unless the parties agree otherwise in writing prior to shipping, Mayfield Courier shall not be financially liable for any special, consequential or other damages caused by delay in the delivery of a shipment, regardless of the cause of such delay.

MAXIMUM LIABILITY

The amount of any loss or damage for which Mayfield Courier may be liable, whether or not the loss or damage results from gross negligence, shall not exceed \$1.50 per pound, computed upon the total weight of the shipment to a maximum of \$100.00. Notwithstanding any disclosure of the nature or value of the goods and the amount of any loss or damages including consequential, incidental or indirect damage, loss of earnings or profits resulting from loss or damage to the goods and/or misdelivery, failure to deliver or delay in delivery of the goods shall not exceed \$100.00.

REFUSAL OF PACKAGES

Mayfield Courier reserves the right to refuse any package by which reason of dangerous or any other character of its contents is liable in the judgement of Mayfield Courier to soil or taint or otherwise damage other merchandise or equipment or which is economically or operationally impractical to transport or which is improperly packaged or wrapped.

APPLICABLE LAW

The contract for the carriage of goods contained in the Bill of Lading shall be deemed to include and be subject to the terms and conditions described by the law of the province of Ontario.

RESTRICTIONS

Mayfield Courier does provide temperature-controlled services if requested prior to shipping, however, any such shipments accepted by Mayfield Courier will travel at shipper's risk within specifications provided by shipper. Mayfield Courier will not accept any dangerous goods which do not comply with the Transportation of dangerous Goods Act and the regulations thereto.

LIMITS

Mayfield Courier shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, either special consequential or otherwise resulting from the following causes: Acts of God, the Queen's or public enemies; Riots; Strikes; Authority of Law; Defect or inherent vice in the goods shipped; Act of default of the shipper or owner of the goods; Nuclear reaction, radiation or radioactive contamination; Road closings; Traffic congestion. Mayfield Courier makes no warranties express or implied, not specifically agreed to in writing prior to shipping.

NOTICE OF LOSS OR DAMAGE

Any damage must be noted on the Bill of Lading at the time of the delivery, otherwise consignee's signature will constitute a clear receipt. Any notice of concealed damage must be given to Mayfield Courier within 24 hours after delivery. Notice of loss or damage must be given to the carrier at its regional office, or its head office within twenty-four (24) hours after such loss or damage becomes known, and in writing within fifteen (15) days after the shipment is accepted by the carrier. NOTE: No liability for loss or damage will be accepted by the carrier unless written notice of such loss or damage is received within fifteen (15) days after the shipment is accepted by the carrier.
